## **General Provisions**

- Persons authorized for the identification and recording of violations and imposition of fines as provided for in these Regulations are policemen.
- Penalties shall not be imposed on any behavior not provided for in the violations table.
- Each violator shall bear the cos of rectifying the violation.
- Any person harmed by the violation shall have the right to file a lawsuit.
- In case of multiple violators in a single violation, the prescribed fine shall be imposed on each violator.
- In case of multiple violations, the violator shall be subject to the fines prescribed for each violation, in accordance with these Regulations.
- Any person again whom a penalty decision is issued, in accordance with these Regulations, may file a grievance before the Public Decency Circuit at the Specialized Administrative Court (Board of Grievances).
